Community Support includes case management to arrange, link or integrate multiple services as well as assessment and reassessment of the recipient's need for services. They also inform recipients about benefits, community resources, and services; assist the recipients in accessing benefits and services; arrange for the recipients to receive benefits and services; and monitor the provision of services. The Community Support Professional provides coordination of movement across levels of care, directly to the person and their family and coordinates discharge planning and community re-entry following hospitalization, residential services and other levels of care (www.righdirectioninc.com).
