First In Families helps people living with Traumatic Brain Injury (of any age) and their families to meet their self-defined needs.

Examples of First In Families Chapter support include assistance with obtaining adaptive equipment, respite, copayment for medical and therapy appointments, home modifications, transportation, household goods and services and much more.

To Qualify for FIFNC Chapter Support

- Individual with TBI lives in one of NC's 100 counties.
- Income of 65K per year per household (after taxes).
- Living alone or with family in the community (not in a licensed setting).



What is Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)?

- Result of external forces, a bump, jolt, or blow to the head directly or indirectly.
- Can lead to potentially chronic challenges affecting not only the person, but the family.
- Common causes are falls, motor vehicle collisions, assaults, or blasts.
